### **Formula SCCA Race Car To Be At San Francisco Auto Show and Available For Testing In December At Thunderhill**

MLC Motorsports of Reno, Nevada working in cooperation with Bulldog Motorsport in Patterson, CA, the SCCA Enterprises, Inc. Customer Service Representatives for the Formula SCCA Race Cars will have an FSCCA car on display at the San Francisco International Auto Show from November 19<sup>th</sup> to the 27<sup>th</sup> at the Moscone Convention Center.

“We plan to have Sean Kelly’s FSCCA car on display during the auto show at the SCCA booth” said Chuck Johnson, owner of MLC Motorsports. “We are proud that Sean took this car to first place for the 2005 season in SCCA’s San Francisco Region’s regional points competition in Formula Atlantic” Johnson stated. The Formula SCCA car is a spec formula car that comes in both an open wheel and sports racer version. It is powered by a 175hp+ 2.3 liter sealed Mazda engine, has a 5 speed sequential gear box, push rod suspension and a modern Formula 1 look to it. “As a spec car, there is no changing gears, springs, shocks, etc. from track to track and the 2.3 Mazda engine is highly reliable all of which contribute to low per race costs in a highly competitive car as evidenced by Sean Kelly’s championship this year”, stated Don Huston owner of Bulldog Motorsport.

In addition to the San Francisco International Auto Show, MLC and Bulldog have scheduled a test drive day on December 17, 2005 at Thunderhill Raceway Park in Willows, California. “We will have the Formula SCCA car available for interested drivers to test on the Thunderhill course in 20 minute solo sessions” stated Huston. “This will allow drivers to test before they buy with no other cars on the track before they commit to a purchase” Huston continued. “The 20 minute sessions will cost \$650.00 of which \$500 will apply to the price of a new car if purchased within 30 days of the test day.
