2006 CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES RULES  
Final Rules**

April 2, 2006

SCCA Enterprises, Inc, MLC Motorsports, LLC and Bulldog Motorsport are pleased to sponsor the 2006 San Francisco Region FSCCA Championship Series. Following are the rules for this year's series.

1. All participants must be a member of SCCA's San Francisco Region and have a completed form W9 on file with SCCA Enterprises, Inc. Prize money will not be paid unless the properly completed W9 is on file.
2. The vehicles will be raced in compliance with the 2006 SCCA Club Racing GCR and the San Francisco Region rules as amended.
3. Sponsors reserve the right, in their reasonable discretion, to amend or modify the Rules and Regulations for the Series at any time via Tech Bulletins or Competitor Bulletins that will be posted on [www.mlcmotorsports.com](http://www.mlcmotorsports.com) and emailed to Series competitors.
4. Points for each race will be awarded in accordance with the San Francisco Region's points system as if the FSCCA had it's own class, i.e. if the first FSCCA car finishes 3<sup>rd</sup> in FA it will receive Series points for first place and so on. Double point's races and bonus races will not count towards the Series Championship, for double points races only the single point scores will be counted.

Points shall be awarded as follows (San Francisco Region Regional System)

The current standings will be posted on [www.mlcmotorsports.com](http://www.mlcmotorsports.com) shortly following each race. Any participant noting a discrepancy should notify Chuck Johnson or Don Huston immediately with all pertinent details in order to justify correction of the standings. Should a non-San Francisco region FSCCA car be entered in a points race, the final results for that race shall be scored as if that car was not entered.

5. All eleven (11) San Francisco Region Regional Races will be official races for this Series, however only the eight (8) highest finishes will be used to determine the Series winners. This will allow some flexibility to participants who have conflicts in work schedules, rain races, etc.
6. Ties for 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Series will be decided by the number of first place finishes; then if necessary, the number of second place finishes, etc. For ties for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, the prize money for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> will be added and then divided equally.
7. The total prize money at this time is \$5,000 which shall be awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$2,500, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$1,500, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$1,000. Should additional prize money or contingency awards become available MLC and Bulldog will determine the distribution of those awards and immediately post them on the web site.
8. Every attempt will be made to award the prizes concurrent with the San Francisco Region's annual awards banquet.
